

Guidelines :

The manuscripts can only be submitted online via the website : *www.historiaORL.com* in standard Word format (Microsoft Word).

Any pictures must have at least **300** dpi with a brief and specific legend.

All the articles and reviews must have an abstract of less than 250 words.

Each person listed as an author is expected to have participated in the study to a significant extent.

Conflicts of interest and sources of funding must be mentioned.

Each author must submit a copyright transfer agreement to the journal. The references are listed in order of appearance in the manuscript and they must be presented as in the examples below (AMA style).

They should be translated into English when the original language is unusual.
In books, the exact page number must be mentioned.
