

The working meeting with the lectures will be held in "Haus Buhl" in Heidelberg Some historical facts about "Haus Buhl"

- 1688 1697 Previous carcass building was destroyed in the Palatin war of succession
 - 1722 "Haus Buhl" was built by architect Johann Jakob Rischer and the house builder Friedrich Gerhard von Lünenschloß; two gates of the previous building were integrated within the new baroque palace
- 1770 1784 Extensive renovations represent the style of transition from late baroqueto early classicism
 - 1889 Heinrich Buhl, lawyer and university professor, acquired "Haus Buhl"
 - 1907 Heinrich Buhl donated the building to his university for a charitable purpose
 - 1938 Hostel for international guests of the University
- 1945 1948 Seat of the Allied
 - 1948 Students' and festival building
 - 1986 Renovation in the style of the late 18th century
 - 2007 Move-in of the Marsilius-Kolleg into the ground floor


